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A. Precautions and Maintenance

 This Interactive Display Media Player is designed for indoor environments and should not be used outdoors or in excessively humid areas.

2. The device should not be exposed to water, condensation, or other liquids to prevent fire, electric shock, or malfunction.

3. Keep the ventilation slots on the back unobstructed to avoid overheating, ensuring there is at least 4 inches (10 cm) of clearance around the unit.

4. The device should not be placed in direct sunlight, near heating devices, or in environments that exceed the recommended temperature range.

5. The device should not be dropped, struck, or have heavy objects placed on it. Always use the provided base or mounting system.
6. Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the device as it may void the warranty and result in injury or permanent damage.

7. Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the display and avoid using liquid or aerosol cleaners.

B. Cleaning the LCD Screen

 The LCD screen is made of glass and can easily be scratched or broken, so handle it with care.

2. To remove fingerprints or dust, use a soft, non-abrasive cloth such as a microfiber or camera lens cloth to gently clean the surface of the screen.

3. If necessary, slightly dampen the cleaning cloth with a screensafe cleaning solution and gently wipe the screen. Avoid applying the solution directly to the screen to prevent moisture damage.

Connecting to Power and Wi-Fi

This device offers flexible power options and robust wireless connectivity for maximum convenience.

A. Power Options

1. Connect the supplied adapter to the power input on the device and plug it into an electrical outlet. The device is ready to use while charging.

2. Equipped with a built-in 15.6Ah battery, the device provides up to 6 hours of continuous use when fully charged. This feature is ideal for outdoor or portable use.

B. Wi-Fi Setup

1. Press the Power Button to turn on the device.

Swipe to access the main menu and navigate to the Settings app.
 Tap on Wi-Fi and select your wireless network from the list of available options.

4. Type the network password and tap Connect. The device supports both 2.4GHz and 5GHz dual-band Wi-Fi for high-speed, stable connections.

Logging in to Google Account

To enjoy all the features of the device, including app downloads and syncing with other devices, you need to log in to your Google Account.

1. Open the Google Play Store pre-installed on the device.

D. Notifications

1. Manage

1.2 Press Notification history to show recent and snoozed notifications.

2. Conversation

2.1 Conversations: Priority and modified conversations will appear here.

2.2 Bubbles: You can toggle Bubbles on or off to allow apps to show bubbles. When this feature is enabled, some conversations will

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appear as floating icons on top of other apps.

3. Privacy

3.1 Press Device and app notifications to control which apps and devices can read notifications.

3.2 Press Notifications on lock screen to show conversations, default and silent notifications.

4. General

4.1 Do Not Disturb Mode: You can choose to turn Do Not Disturb mode on or off. In the Do Not Disturb settings, you can customize exceptions to ensure certain notifications are not affected by the mode.

2. You can turn Do Not Disturb mode on or off, as well as enable Live Captioning, which automatically captions speech.

 To enable shortcut to prevent ringing, first change "Press and hold Power button" to the Power menu.

 Tap and then swipe to set the default notification sound and default alarm sound.

5. Tap this area to switch to dial pad tones, screen locking sound charging sounds, and touch sound.

6. Open the Sound enhancement to improve the sound.

2. Install the Base and Support Poles

2.1 Place the base on a flat surface, ensuring it is stable.

2.2 Take the support poles and align their bottoms with the connection holes on the base.

Using the provided screws, secure the support poles to the base. Tighten the screws on the back of the base.

Tip: Tighten the screws securely to avoid the support poles becoming loose.

3. Install the Display Screen

3.1 Confirm that the mounting bracket on the back of the display screen is aligned with the connection piece at the top of the support poles.

3.2 Firmly slide or mount the display screen onto the top of the support poles.

3.3 To remove, slide the mounting latch down and gently lift off the display screen.

Note: Do not use excessive force to avoid damaging the screen or the support pole connection.

4. Adjust the Angle

4.1 Adjust the angle or height of the display screen as needed.
4.2 Ensure all connections are tightened to prevent the screen from wobbling or falling during use.

5. Installation Check

5.1 Confirm that all screws and connectors are tightened properly.
5.2 Check that the display screen is secure and does not wobble.
5.3 Place the device on a stable surface to ensure the base remains

steady without movement.

Troubleshooting Guide

1. Check Power and Charging: Ensure that the tablet is connected to a working charger and power outlet.

 Allow at least 30 minutes of charging before attempting to turn it on.

3. Force Restart: Press and hold the power button for 15-10 seconds to initiate a forced restart.

4. Inspect Buttons: Check that the power button is not stuck or damaged.

Blank or Black Screen

1. Adjust Brightness: Verify whether the brightness is set too low, and adjust it accordingly.

 Force Restart: Hold down both the power and volume down buttons simultaneously until the device restarts.

3. External Connections: If an external display is connected, ensure the proper connection is made and test with a different cable if necessary.

Unresponsive Touchscreen

 Clean the Screen: Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and remove any dust or smudges.

2. Remove Accessories: Take off any screen protectors or cases that may interfere with touch sensitivity.

3. Restart the Tablet: Turn off the tablet and restart it.

4. Screen Calibration: Navigate to the settings and perform touchscreen calibration, if available.

WiFi Connectivity Issues

1. Check Network: Ensure the WiFi router is working, and other devices can connect to it.
