## Schematic View




## **Charging Guide**

- 1. When the battery is low, charge it using any wireless charger that supports the Qi standard.
- 2. The Smart Finder features a built-in, rechargeable 100mAh Lithium Polymer battery.
- 3. The LED light will turn red during charging and change to green once fully charged.


## Instructions for Use

- 1. Switch on/off the unit
- 1.1 Switch on: Press the function button briefly. You will hear a chime, indicating that the unit is powered on and in pairing mode.
- 1.2 Switch off: Press and hold the function button for three seconds until you hear two beeps, indicating that the unit is powered off.
- 2. Add Your Smart Finder to the Find My App
- 2.1 Open the Find My app on your supported iPhone, iPad, iPod Touch, or Mac computer.
- 2.2 Allow notifications from the app.




2.3 At the bottom, select Items, then tap Add Other Item or directly tap the "+" icon.

**2.4** Choose Other Supported Items from the list.




2.5 Ensure your Smart Finder is close to your phone. It will display "Searching Items."



2.6 pop-up will appear with "PPBCHAX." Tap Connect.




2.7 Follow the pop-up to enter the name, select an emoji to represent the item, and tap Continue.






2.8 When the "This Item Is Linked to Your Apple ID" pop-up appears, tap Agree.




2.9 Tap Finish to complete the setup of your Smart Finder.



### **Function Introduction**


- Find Items: Tap Play Sound to make your Smart Finder beep when it's nearby.
- 2. Find Your Item's Location: Your Smart Finder's last known location will appear on the map with the emoji you selected during setup. Tap Directions to navigate to the last known location.



## **Notification Setting**

- 1. Enable the "Notify When Found" toggle. When your Smart Finder's location is detected by another Find My enabled device, you will receive a notification with the updated location.
- 2. Enable the "Notify When Left Behind" toggle. You will receive a notification when you leave your Smart Finder behind and it is no longer in range of your device.

Note: The "Notify When Found" feature can only be activated when your Smart Finder is out of range.




## Lost Mode

- 1. When your Smart Finder is lost and you activate "Lost Mode", tap the "Enable" tab. A screen will appear calling Lost Mode, tap "Continue". You can enter your phone number or email address and tap "Next".
- 2. You can also enter a message that will be shared with the person who finds your Smart Finder.
- Tap "Activate" to enable Lost Mode.

#### Note:

When Lost Mode is enabled, "Notification When Found" is automatically turned on.

When Lost Mode is enabled, your Smart Finder is locked and cannot be paired with a new device.




### Rename Item

You can rename your Smart Finder device.

### Remove Item


- 1. Ensure that "Lost Mode" is disabled, then click "Remove Item". After selecting this option, a confirmation pop-up will appear with "Remove Item?". Click "Remove" to reset the device.
- 2. The Smart Finder is now reset and ready to be paired with a new device.



#### **Share This Item**

- 1. Tap "Add Person" to share the item.
- 2. Tap "Continue" and select the people you want to share with.
- 3. Tap "Share" and wait for the selected people to confirm your invitation.
- 4. Others can also locate this item, but tracking notifications will be muted.

Note: This feature is available for iOS 17 and above.

#### **About the Find My App**

- 1. The Apple Find My network provides a simple and secure way to locate this item using the Find My app on your iPhone, iPad, Mac, or the Find Items app on Apple Watch.
- 2. To use the Apple Find My app to locate this item, the latest version of iOS, iPadOS, or macOS is recommended. The Find Items app on Apple Watch requires the latest version of watchOS.

#### **Additional Information**

- 1. This item can be found by its owner using the Find My app. For more information, follow the instructions below.
- 2. Locate the button on the side of the device.
- Press the button twice. You will hear a confirmation sound.

#### **How to Disable**

- 1. Find the button on the side of the device.
- 2. Press and hold the function button for three seconds until you hear two beeps. This will stop sharing the location of your Smart Finder.

## Factory Reset

- Press the button four times rapidly, then hold it for a fifth time until you hear a ringing chime.
- 2. A reset operation is required to re-enable the device to enter pairing mode again. This includes synchronization with Find My, which requires unbinding the previous connection, and re-binding the new Apple ID account.



#### **Malicious Tracking Safety**

If someone else's device mixes with your belongings and tracks it over a period of time, you will be reminded in the following ways:

- 2. If you have an iPhone, iPad, or iPod Touch (or any Apple device), you will receive alerts on your Apple device. This feature is available on iOS or iPadOS version 14.5 or above.
- 3. If someone else's device finds its way into your belongings, your iPhone will notice it is traveling with you and send you an alert. After a while, if you still have not found it, the Smart Finder will start playing a sound to help you locate it.

#### **Important Tips**

When pairing a device with the Find My app, the phone will link to the Apple server. Pairing may fail due to network issues. The following actions are recommended:

a. Change the phone's network, such as switching between Wi-Fi and mobile data. The first pairing may take some time, so please

be patient.

- b. Reset your Smart Finder.
- c. When "Lost Mode" is enabled, DO NOT REMOVE ITEM in the app. This item will be locked and cannot be paired with a new device.
