# AURA SMART WATCH with 1.73" Display

## Product Overview

- Touchscreen: Displays watch data. Swipe or tap the screen to navigate and select functions.
- 2. Side Button:

Press and hold to power the device on or off.

Press briefly to access the menu interface.

- 3. Heart Rate Sensor
- 4. Blood Oxygen Sensor



### **Charging the Smartwatch**

- 1. Before first use, ensure the smartwatch is fully charged.
- 2. A full charge takes approximately 2 hours. Once connected to a power source, the smartwatch will begin charging automatically.
- 3. Attach the charging cable securely to the charging pins on the back of the smartwatch, then connect the other end of the cable to a power source.



- 1. Before downloading the Oplayer Smart Life app, confirm that it is compatible with your smartphone. The app supports iOS 10.0 or later and Android 5.0 or later.
- 2. Search for Oplayer Smart Life in the App Store or Google Play, or scan the provided QR code to install.

- 3. Enable Bluetooth on your smartphone, open the "Oplayer Smart Life" app, and create your profile. Then, in the app settings, select "Connect Smartwatch" and choose the device named "Aura" from the list.
- 4. To disconnect your smartwatch, open the app settings and select "Forget This Smartwatch". For iPhone users: In addition to the above, go to "Bluetooth" in iOS Settings and select "Forget This Device".

### **Function Guide**

- Hold the "Side Button" for 3 seconds to power on the smartwatch.
   Swipe up, down, left, or right on the "Touchscreen" to access additional options.
- 2. After powering on, the default "Watch Face" is displayed. Press and hold for 5 seconds to select a different "Watch Face" of your choice.

🔁 4. Notifications: Swipe up on the "Dial Interface" to view notifications such as incoming calls, text messages, QQ, WeChat, WhatsApp, Facebook, Twitter, etc. Notifications can be deleted automatically after reading.

5. Menus: When the "Watch Face" is displayed, swipe right to access and view all menus.



6. "Activity": Records daily steps, calories, and workout time.



7. "Dial": After pairing the smartphone with the watch via "Bluetooth", tap this icon to make a call.

8. Contacts: After connecting the "Oplayer Smart Life" app, open the app and go to "Sync Contacts" in Settings. Add or update contact information, which will then be displayed on the watch after saving.



9. Multi-Sport Modes: Tap the "Sport" icon to enter multi-sport modes. To end a session, swipe from left to right on the screen and tap the "Stop" ( 🔼 ) icon to finish and save your sports data.

- 10. Sport Goal: Tap the "Goal" icon to set your sport target.
- 11. Goal Reminder: A notification will appear once your sport data reaches the set goal.




🕥 12. Heart Rate: The smartwatch records your "Heart Rate" continuously throughout the day. You may also tap on the "Heart Rate" page to manually start measurement.


- 13. Stress Monitoring: Tap the "Pressure" page to begin measuring blood pressure. The page also displays the results of your most recent measurements.
- 14. SpO₂: Tap the "SpO₂" function to begin measuring blood oxygen levels. The function also displays previously recorded SpO₂ data.
- 15. Sleep Monitor: The "Sleep Monitor" function automatically tracks sleep patterns between 9:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m.
- 16. Weather: The "Weather" function displays real-time weather information when the smartwatch is connected to the "Oplayer Smart Life" app.
- 17. World Clock: The "World Clock" function allows you to view the time in multiple locations worldwide.
- 18. Cycle Tracking: The "Cycle Tracking" function helps monitor and record menstrual cycle information.
- 19. Shutter: Use the "Shutter" function to remotely capture photos from your smartphone through the smartwatch.
- 20. Music Control

  Tap the "Music" icon to access the music playback control interface. From here, you can select previous or next tracks, and play or pause music. Adjust the volume by using the control buttons, and tap the icon to toggle the audio output between the smartwatch and the connected phone. To exit the music controls,
- 21. Settings
- 21.1 "Settings"

swipe left to right on the screen.

- 21.2 "Display"
- 21.3 "Sleep" Adjusts the duration the screen remains lit.
- 21.4 Visual Style: You can select cards with different switching styles in the "Visual Style" function.
- 21.5 Charging Style: The "Charging Style" function allows you to customize how the charging interface appears.
- 21.6 Watch Face: Tap the "Watch Face" function to select and change the display of your smartwatch's face.





- 21.9 Vibration Adjustment: In the "Vibration Adjustment" function, you can modify the vibration intensity of the smartwatch. Options include: no vibration, weak, or strong.
- 21.10 Do Not Disturb Mode: Enable "Do Not Disturb Mode" to disconnect the Bluetooth connection and restrict the smartwatch to only recording steps, heart rate, body temperature, and blood oxygen levels.
- 21.11 Low Power Mode: Enable "Low Power Mode" to conserve battery life.
- 21.12 Call Switch, Media Audio Switch, Call Reset: The "Call Switch" function allows you to switch between audio sources. The "Media Audio Switch" adjusts the media output, and "Call Reset" resets the current call.
- 21.13 Screen Clock: Use the "Screen Clock" function to display the time on the screen when the watch is idle.
- 21.14 About: In the "About" section, you can find the MAC Address and the software version of your smartwatch.
- 21.15 Power Off: Tap the "Power Off" icon to turn off your smartwatch.
- 21.16 Reboot: Use the "Reboot" function to restart the smartwatch.
- 21.17 Reset: Tap the "Reset" icon to clear all data on the smartwatch. This will reset the device to its factory settings.

### Precautions

- 1. The smartwatch is designed for use in normal environmental conditions. Avoid exposing it to extremely high or low temperatures to prevent potential damage to its internal components, such as the 380mAh battery.
- 2. While the IP68 water resistance level protects the watch from dust and water, it is important not to submerge it for prolonged periods or in deep water to avoid water damage.

- 3. To ensure safe charging, always use the 3H charging time with the supplied charger or a certified replacement. Using an uncertified charger may damage the battery and void the warranty.
- 4. Although the zinc alloy case provides durability, high-impact shocks or drops may cause internal damage. Handle the smartwatch carefully to prevent damage to its screen and internal components.
- 5. While the battery lasts up to 7 days with normal use, do not leave the smartwatch on charging for extended periods (beyond the recommended 3H charging time) to prevent battery degradation.
- 6. Strong magnetic fields can interfere with the Bluetooth 5.4 connection and other internal components. Avoid placing the smartwatch near magnets or electronic devices emitting high magnetic fields.
- 7. To maintain the appearance and functionality of the 1.73" AMOLED screen and other components, clean the smartwatch regularly using a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could scratch the display.
- 8. Before pairing with your phone, confirm that your smartphone is running Android 8.0+ or iOS 12+ to ensure smooth connectivity via Bluetooth 5.4.
- 9. Prolonged contact with the smartwatch strap may cause skin irritation for some individuals. If irritation occurs, remove the smartwatch and allow the skin to rest. Clean the strap regularly to avoid buildup of dirt or sweat.
- 10. The smartwatch should not be left on the charger after it is fully charged to avoid unnecessary strain on the battery. Unplug the charger once the smartwatch is fully charged to preserve battery life.

This product must not be disposed of as unsorted household waste. It is important to separate such waste for proper treatment and recycling, in compliance with local waste management regulations.
